In continuation of this Department's letter No.20-1/2009-NFSM (CAV) dated 25.4.2011 conveying Administrative Approval for implementation of National Food Security Mission-2011-12 and letter no 20-3/2011-NFSM CA-V dated 7/06/2011 conveying approval of action plan for NFSM-Rice in three districts viz. Jammu, Samba, Kathua of Jammu & Kashmir during 2011-12, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the payment of first installment of grants-in-aid of **Rs.2,69,06,000/- (Rupees two Crore sixty nine Lakhs six thousand only)** to SAMETI, Jammu (Implementing Agency of Jammu & Kashmir) for implementation of NFSM-Rice during 2011-12 as per details given below:-


2. This release is subject to the condition that all terms and conditions laid down in the administrative approval issued vide letter of even number dated 25.4.2011 are followed. However, it is reiterated that MPRs to be furnished should invariably include physical/financial targets/achievements separately. A format in this regard is already circulated. This is also tentative and subject to variation/adjustment as the Govt. of India may decide for this programme during the current financial year (2011-12) in due course. The implementing agency is requested to furnish the Utilization Certification in the prescribed proforma GFR-19(A) to this Department at the end of the financial year. They are also requested to submit Monthly Progress Report for both physical and financial achievements regularly along with quarterly expenditure statements.

3. The aforesaid expenditure may be debited to the following Heads of Account: -
