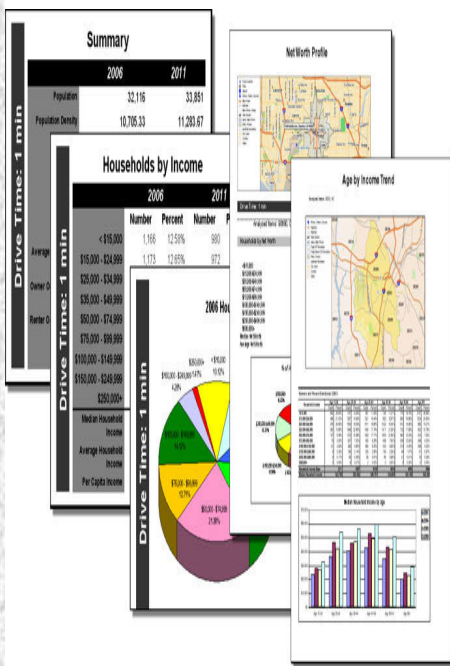



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PERSPECTIVE OF RECORD KEEPING, REPORTING & MONITORING UNDER NFSM

The “Operational Guidelines” of National Food Security Mission envisages the planning for the information generation & dissemination within the project itself, as well as in relation between the project and its environment. Thus, the structure of flow of information of the mission is broadly outlined as under:

- Within the mission itself, each member of the mission generates information that has to flow to others. At the same time, each one depends on the information of others;
- the mission generates information pertaining to programme planning, implementation and monitoring within its environment; and
- its development often depends on information to be provided by the outside the domain of the mission e.g. new crop production technologies developed by ICAR Crop Improvement Projects, Weather forecast by IMD, Soil nutrient status by AILUS etc.

In this respect, planning of the information involves:

- information generation and its dissemination within and outside of the mission concerning the activities of the NFSM; and
- identification of the requisite external sources of information and the ways to obtain it.

Information planning has to:

- define the information to be registered within the NFSM;
- fix the procedure of generation, distribution and filing of this information;
- monitor the implementation of the information management activities according to the mission mode.

The information generated under NFSM necessarily need be in public domain which refers to the total absence of copyright protection

for a creative work (such as a EFC memo, Operational guidelines, compendium of record management & monitoring formats, handbook for concurrent evaluation, mid-term evaluation reports, impact evaluation reports, NFSM emblem, success stories, photographs, video-graphy, articles and computer program for online monitoring).

Subsequently, the identification of stakeholders is the next step for sourcing of information under NFSM. The stakeholder refers to a person, group or organization that has direct or indirect stake in NFSM because it can affect or be affected by the NFSM's actions, objectives and policies. Key stakeholders in NFSM include:

(1) NFSM Cell in Crops Division, Department of Agriculture & Cooperation, Union Ministry of Agriculture and National Consultants and supporting staff;

(2) ICRISAT;

(3) National level Seed production & supply organizations namely; National Seeds Corporation Ltd & State Farms Corporation of India;

(4) Indian Institute of Pulse Research, ICAR;

(5) KVKs under the administrative control of ICAR in the project area of NFSM;

(6) Private Seed Companies engaged in production & supply of Certified/labeled seeds of rice, wheat & pulses;

(7) State Department of Agriculture & State as well as district NFSM consultants and supporting staff;

(8) ATMA's

(9) State Seeds Corporations;

(10) State Seed Certification Agencies;

(11) Licensed Public & private sector Input dealers;

(12) Cooperative sector seed producing & supply agencies;

(13) Cooperative sector Input supplying agencies other than seeds;

(14) NGO's; and

(15) Beneficiary farmers.

Once the identification of stakeholders and their role is accomplished, the generation of information becomes imperative. In order to generate the information under NFSM, it is necessary to define the information to be registered with it and also devise the procedure of collection, collation, storage and dissemination. The process of the aforesaid aspects is illustrated as under:-

2. Maintenance of activity specific records of NFSM at Panchayat, district & State levels: The records need be maintained agriculture season wise at all the levels. In order to ensure uniformity in season wise reporting, the period of agriculture seasons across states need be followed as under:-

- **Kharif season:** sowings commencing in the month of April including nursery raising and completing by end of August;
- **Rabi season:** sowings commencing in the month of September including nursery raising and completed by end of December;
- **Summer season:** sowings commencing in the month of January including nursery raising and completed by end of March.

The records prescribed at these levels are as under:

2.1 Panchayat level: The panchayat level NFSM functionary will maintain the following records relating to implementation of NFSM in his jurisdiction:-

PL-1: Record of supply of inputs for demonstrations of Improved Package of Practices (Wheat/Rice)/SRI-Rice Demonstrations/Hybrid Rice Demonstrations.

PL-2: Record of application of inputs for demonstrations of Improved Package of Practices (Wheat/Rice)/SRI-Rice Demonstrations/Hybrid Rice Demonstrations.

PL-3: Panchayat Level visitor's record.

PL-4: Record of incentivized supply of HYV seeds under assistance for distribution of High Yielding Varieties (HYV) Seeds/Hybrid rice seeds.

PL-5: Record of supply of seed minikit under distribution of seed minikits.

PL-6: Record of incentivized supply of micro-nutrients.

- PL-7: Record of supply of plant protection chemicals & bio-pesticides in rice and IPM in pulses.
- PL-8: Record of incentivized supply of liming material.
- PL-9: Record of incentivized supply of gypsum.
- PL-10: Record of incentivized supply of farm implements.
- PL-11: Record of incentivized supply of pump sets.
- PL-12: Record of incentivized supply of sprinkler sets.
- PL-13: Record of incentivized supply of community generator.
- PL-14: Venue/session/topic specific list of trainee farmers in Farmers Field School (FFS).
- PL-14(a): Record of number of participants / sessions / topics / expenditure incurred under Farmers' Field School (FFS).

2.2 District level: The district level NFSM functionary will maintain the following records relating to implementation of NFSM in his jurisdiction: -

- DL-1(a): Management of actual and committed expenditure at district level for NFSM rice.
- DL-1(b): Management of actual and committed expenditure at district level for NFSM wheat.
- DL-1(c): Management of actual and committed expenditure at district level for NFSM pulses.
- DL-2: Record of miscellaneous expenditure for project management team & other expenses at district level.

2.3 State level: The State level NFSM functionary will maintain the following records relating to implementation of NFSM in his jurisdiction: -

- SL-1(a): Management of actual and committed expenditure at state level for NFSM rice.
- SL-1(b): Management of actual and committed expenditure at state level for NFSM wheat.
- SL-1(c): Management of actual and committed expenditure at state level for NFSM pulses.
- SL-2: Record of miscellaneous expenditure for project management team & other expenses at state level.

3. Planning of the information outside the NFSM: In order to testify the information generated through NFSM and to triangulate the information so generated under NFSM with the information generated from outside sources to achieve the set objectives of the mission, the sources of outside information need be

identified. The existing system of defining, generation, distribution and filing of the information adopted by outside agencies will be utilized for triangulation.

The key sources of information outside NFSM are: -

- (1) Input Divisions of DAC;
- (2) Central Input Testing Laboratories for referee testing of quality of Inputs;
- (3) India Meteorological Department;
- (4) Directorate of Economic & Statistics;

- (8) Directorate of Rice Research, ICAR;
- (9) Subject matter Divisions of ICAR other than Crop Improvement Directorates;

- (11) Input Law Enforcement Wings in the SDA;
- (12) State Seed Corporations outside the domain of NFSM;
- (13) SSCA's outside the domain of NFSM;
- (14) State Soil testing Laboratories;
- (15) Regional Fertilizer testing laboratories;
- (16) State Governments line departments/agencies responsible for release of canal water from canals/tube wells and supply of electricity;
- (17) SAUs;
- (18) Evaluation agencies;
- (19) International organizations (CIMMYT, IRRI & ICARDA);
- (20) Central Procurement agencies;
- (21) State Procurement agencies; and
- (22) Non-beneficiary farmers.

In order to comprehend the progress of the mission, the baseline data (TE: 2006-07) pertaining to specific indicators has been prescribed in the *baseline survey format*.
