In continuation to this Department's letter No. CPS. 2-1/2016-NFSM dated 23rd March, 2016 and reference to State Government's letter No-----dated-----, forwarding therewith the Action Plan of NFSM for an amount of **Rs.....lakh** for the year 2016-17, I am directed to convey the approval of competent authority for implementation of NFSM in the State of..... with total outlay of **Rs.....lakh** (Rs.....lakh as GOI share and **Rs.....lakh** as State share) on 60:40/90:10 sharing basis between GOI and State. This allocation comprises of **Rs.....lakh** (Rs.....lakh as GOI share and Rs.....lakh as State share) for NFSM-Rice, **Rs.....lakh** (Rs.....lakh as GOI share and Rs.....lakh as State share) for NFSM-Wheat, **Rs.....lakh** (Rs.....lakh as GOI share and Rs.....lakh as State share) for NFSM-Pulses and **Rs.....lakh** (Rs.....lakh as GOI share and Rs.....lakh as State share) for NFSM-Coarse Cereals.

The crop-wise and intervention-wise physical targets and outlays as approved by GOI is at **Annexures-I to IV**.

The State shall implement the Action Plan as per norms of NFSM guidelines. The varieties of Rice, Wheat and Coarse Cereals used shall not be more than 10 years old. However, for cluster demonstrations and seed distribution in Pulses, varieties up to 15 years old are permissible. The varieties of pulses not older than 10 years are allowed for production of quality seeds. Further, state has to ensure that at least 30% of seed of stress tolerant rice varieties are used under demonstrations and seed distribution.

State should conduct at least 30% demonstrations under cropping system based approach under rice, wheat and pulses component of NFSM. States also promote planting of arhar on rice bunds under demonstrations of rice.
