**Subject:** Implementation of Centrally Sponsored Scheme on "National Food Security Mission (NFSM)-Approval of Action Plan of NFSM for the year 2016-17-regarding.

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Sir,

In continuation to this Department's letter No. CPS. 2-1/2016-NFSM dated 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2016 and reference to State Government's letter No. MD/SAMA/NFSM/2016-17-Action Plan/2016-17 dated 20.05.2016 from Mission Director (SAMA) forwarding therewith the Action Plan of NFSM for an amount of **Rs. 22203.000 lakh** for the year 2016-17 and also additional information furnished through E mail on 31.05.2016, I am directed to convey the approval of competent authority for implementation of NFSM in the State of **Karnataka** with total outlay of **Rs. 22095.305 lakh** (Rs. 13257.183 lakh as GOI share and Rs. 8838.122 lakh as State share) on **60:40** sharing basis between GOI and State. This allocation comprises of **Rs. 1600.000 lakh** (Rs. 960.000 lakh as GOI share and Rs. 640.000 lakh as State share) for **NFSM-Rice**, **Rs. 16894.305 lakh** (Rs. 10136.583 lakh as GOI share and Rs. 6757.722 lakh as State share) for **NFSM-Pulses** and **Rs. 3601.000 lakh** (Rs. 2160.600 lakh as GOI share and Rs. 1440.400 lakh as State share) for **NFSM-Coarse Cereals**.

The crop-wise and intervention-wise physical targets and outlays as approved by GOI is at **Annexures-I to III**.

The State shall implement the Action Plan as per norms of NFSM guidelines. The varieties of **Rice and Coarse Cereals** used shall not be more than 10 years old. However, for cluster demonstrations and seed distribution in Pulses, varieties up to 15 years old are permissible. The varieties of pulses not older than 10 years are allowed for production of quality seeds. Further, state has to ensure that at least 30% of seed of stress tolerant rice varieties are used under demonstrations and seed distribution.

State should conduct at least 30% demonstrations under cropping system based approach under **rice and pulses component of NFSM**. States also promote planting of arhar on rice bunds under demonstrations of rice within approved norms of Rs. 7500/-per ha.
