Subject: Implementation of the programme of "**Bringing Green Revolution to Eastern India (BGREI)**" in the State of Uttar Pradesh during 2017-18 regarding.

Sir,

Kindly refer to your letter No. W & M/183/ BGREI/02/2017-18 dated 01.06.2017 forwarding therewith the Action Plan of the above mentioned programme in respect of Rice & Wheat crops for the year 2017-18 for an amount of **Rs. 9707.985 lakh**, I am directed to convey the approval of competent authority for implementation of above mentioned programme in the State of Uttar Pradesh with an outlay of **Rs. 9707.985 lakh comprising of Rs. 7785.805 lakh for Rice and Rs. 1922.180 lakh for Wheat for the year 2017-18 shared between GOI and State share at 60:40 ratio with Rs. 5824.791 as GOI share and Rs. 3883.194 lakh as State share.**

The intervention-wise physical targets & outlays as proposed by State vis-à-vis approved by GOI in respect of **both for Rice & Wheat** are at **Annexures-I & II**, respectively.

The State shall implement the programme as per the norms contained in BGREI guidelines. **The varieties of seeds of Rice & Wheat used shall not be more than 10 years old.** Further, State has to ensure that at least 30% of funds allocated each for Cluster demonstrations and seed distribution may be utilized for promotion of stress tolerant varieties of rice. Further, the cafeteria furnished by the State for Cluster demonstrations may also be discussed with SAU and got approved and follow the same cafeteria as approved for NFSM in BGREI for all type of demonstrations to avoid confusion.

It is further requested that these Action Plans, as approved by GOI, may kindly be discussed in the meeting of State Steering Committee (SSC) and got the same approved by State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) or the Chief Secretary subject to ex-post facto approval of State Level Sanctioning Committee and intimated to this Ministry to facilitate release of first installment of GOI share.

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
