Rice: About **23.50 lakh ha** area coverage under Summer Rice has been reported compared to **25.95 lakh ha** of the last year. Thus **2.45 lakh ha** less area has been covered compared to last year. The area has been reported mainly from the States of West Bengal (11.90 lakh ha), Odisha (2.53 lakh ha), Assam (2.41 lakh ha), Bihar (1.25 lakh ha), Chhatisgarh (1.20 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (0.83 lakh ha), Maharashtra (0.70 lakh ha), Tripura (0.64 lakh ha), Karnataka (0.64 lakh ha), Gujarat (0.56 lakh ha), Kerala (0.44 lakh ha), Madhya Pradesh (0.23 lakh ha), Uttar Pradesh (0.10 lakh ha) and Jharkhand (0.09 lakh ha).

Pulses: About **12.52 lakh ha** area coverage under Summer Pulses has been reported compared to **10.75 lakh ha** of the last year. Thus **1.78 lakh ha** more area has been covered compared to last year. The area has been reported mainly from the States of Bihar (2.95 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (2.31 lakh ha), Odisha (2.14 lakh ha), Madhya Pradesh (1.51 lakh ha), Uttar Pradesh (1.36 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (0.74 lakh ha), West Bengal (0.61 lakh ha), Gujarat (0.40 lakh ha), Chhattisgarh (0.18 lakh ha), Punjab (0.14 lakh ha), Karnataka (0.09 lakh ha), Rajasthan (0.04 lakh ha), Jharkhand (0.04 lakh ha) and Maharashtra (0.02 lakh ha).

Coarse cereals: About **8.25 lakh ha** area coverage under Summer Coarse cereals has been reported compared to **7.67 lakh ha** of the last year. Thus **0.58 lakh ha** more area has been covered compared to last year. The area under summer coarse cereals has been reported mainly from the States of Gujarat (2.66 lakh ha), Bihar (1.69 lakh ha), Uttar Pradesh (1.26 lakh ha), Maharashtra (0.77 lakh ha), West Bengal (0.60 lakh ha), Chhattisgarh (0.34 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (0.32 lakh ha), Karnataka (0.24 lakh ha), Assam (0.19 lakh ha), Madhya Pradesh (0.10 lakh ha) and Odisha (0.07 lakh ha).

Oilseeds: About **9.29 lakh ha** area coverage under Summer Oilseeds has been reported compared to **7.88 lakh ha** of the last year. Thus **1.41 lakh ha** more area has been covered compared to last year. The area has been reported mainly from the States of West Bengal (3.12 lakh ha), Karnataka (1.30 lakh ha), Maharashtra (1.19 lakh ha), Uttar Pradesh (0.93 lakh ha), Gujarat (0.91 lakh ha), Odisha (0.53 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (0.47 lakh ha), Chhattisgarh (0.24 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (0.18 lakh ha), Telangana (0.14 lakh ha), Rajasthan (0.07 lakh ha), Madhya Pradesh (0.06 lakh ha), Punjab (0.06 lakh ha), Haryana (0.05 lakh ha) and Bihar (0.04 lakh ha).
